

## Q1 How many AIC Annual Meetings have you attended in the last 10 years?





### Q2 Did you attend the 2017 Annual Meeting in Chicago?





### Q3 Are you planning on attending the 2018 Annual Meeting in Houston?






# Q5 To which specialty groups do you belong? (please check all that apply)






# Q7 Please rank the following suggested meeting themes for the 2019 meeting in order of preference with 1 being the most preferred and 5 being the least preferred.








