#### Joining the Virtual Event

**Step 2:** Enter the email you registered with and select enter.

#### **Live Sessions**



**PLEASE NOTE:** Only <u>active</u> live streams are clickable in this view. If a session has concluded or if it is scheduled at a future time, you will not be able to click on its bar.

**Questions?** Interact with speakers directly through the chat and q&a tool located on right side of that page.

Click Open chat and Q&A and the chat and Q&A tool will appear. From there, engage with attendees and speakers by typing text in the designated field and clicking 'enter.'

## **On Demand**



The **On Demand** section gives you access to all the recorded content from previous sessions. Click 'On Demand' on your navigation bar and select the session you'd like to view.

Upon selecting your session, a menu bar will appear with all the talks in the session. Select the talk you would like to watch.





If the talk is available, it will automatically start playing. If it has not yet processed or if it's happening at a future date, you will see a holding screen.

### On Demand (cont.)



Like the live sessions, attendees are able to engage with their peers speakers directly through the chat and q&a tool located right side of that page.

Click <sup>Open chat and Q&A</sup> and the chat and Q&A tool will appear.



To access the other talks in the session, click on 'More Session Videos' and a menu will appear with the remaining talks. From there, you will be able to view the next talk of your choosing.

### On Demand (cont.)

Use Breakout's powerful filter tool to help you find exactly what you're looking for. It is located on the top of the 'On Demand' page.



Select a category from the dropdown menu, choose a date or type directly into the search bar to narrow down nearly results. See example below:



## Agenda

## Frequently Asked Questions and Troubleshooting

#### 1. I missed the start of the session, can I view it from the start?

Yes! When you arrive to a session, it will automatically start where the session currently is. Scroll over the video and the video menu bar will appear. Just click to any point prior to the current time you'd like to see and you will be brought to that point of the session.

#### 2. Can I watch a session later or on demand?

Yes! To view past sessions and talks, click on the 'On Demand' button located on the left navigation bar. This will direct you to all previously recorded sessions.

## 3. What can I do if I'm on a previously recorded session page and the content won't play?

Check to see if you are logged into the event first. Then see if the session you are trying to see has already taken place or if it's schedule for a future date. If it has already taken place, try refreshing your browser.

# 4. Do I need to download or install and software to participate in this year's event?

No! You do not need to download anything to participate.

#### 5. Is a webcam required?

There is no need for a webcam while viewing content. There are plenty of ways for you to interact with attendees and speakers through session chats and Q&A.

## 6. What should I enable on my browser to make sure I have a good attendee experience?

Please be sure to allow browser cookies and turn off any VPNs connected to your browser.
