Assessing Collections


- Before

 - · Are copies of materials available off-site?
 - Identify most important collections.
- After
 - Assess the damage.
 - http://bit.ly/Disaster_Form
 - Take your time.
 - Implement procedures or disaster plan.

Supplies

- Fans (box and oscillating)
- Clothesline, clips
- Folding tables
- Flashlights
- Paper towels and/or cotton painter rags
- Sponges
- Plastic sheeting (Visqueen)
- Dehumidifiers
- Scissors, pens, pencils, paper
- Power strips and electrical cords

- Door wedges
