

State of Texas Alliance for Response Team (START) Strategic Directions 2004

- 1. To act as a clearinghouse for resources and information about disaster planning, response and recovery, via Web sites, resource tables at conferences, etc.
- 2. To act as a Speakers Bureau and disseminate information via presentations at appropriate professional conferences by developing talking points and presentations.
- 3. To facilitate the development of the START Initiative in the State of Texas:
 - a. To initiate committees in regional areas of the state;
 - b. To facilitate the development of ongoing regional meetings within the state;
 - c. To act as a liaison between the regional committees and the START Core Planning Committee;
 - d. To develop a needs assessment instrument in order to gather information on disaster-related needs within the state of Texas;
 - e. To secure funding to support the development of the START Initiative; and
 - f. To explore methods of sustainability of the START Initiative once funded.
- 4. To provide education, outreach, and advocacy-regionally and statewideabout disaster planning, response, and recovery.
